#### 4. 2018-2019

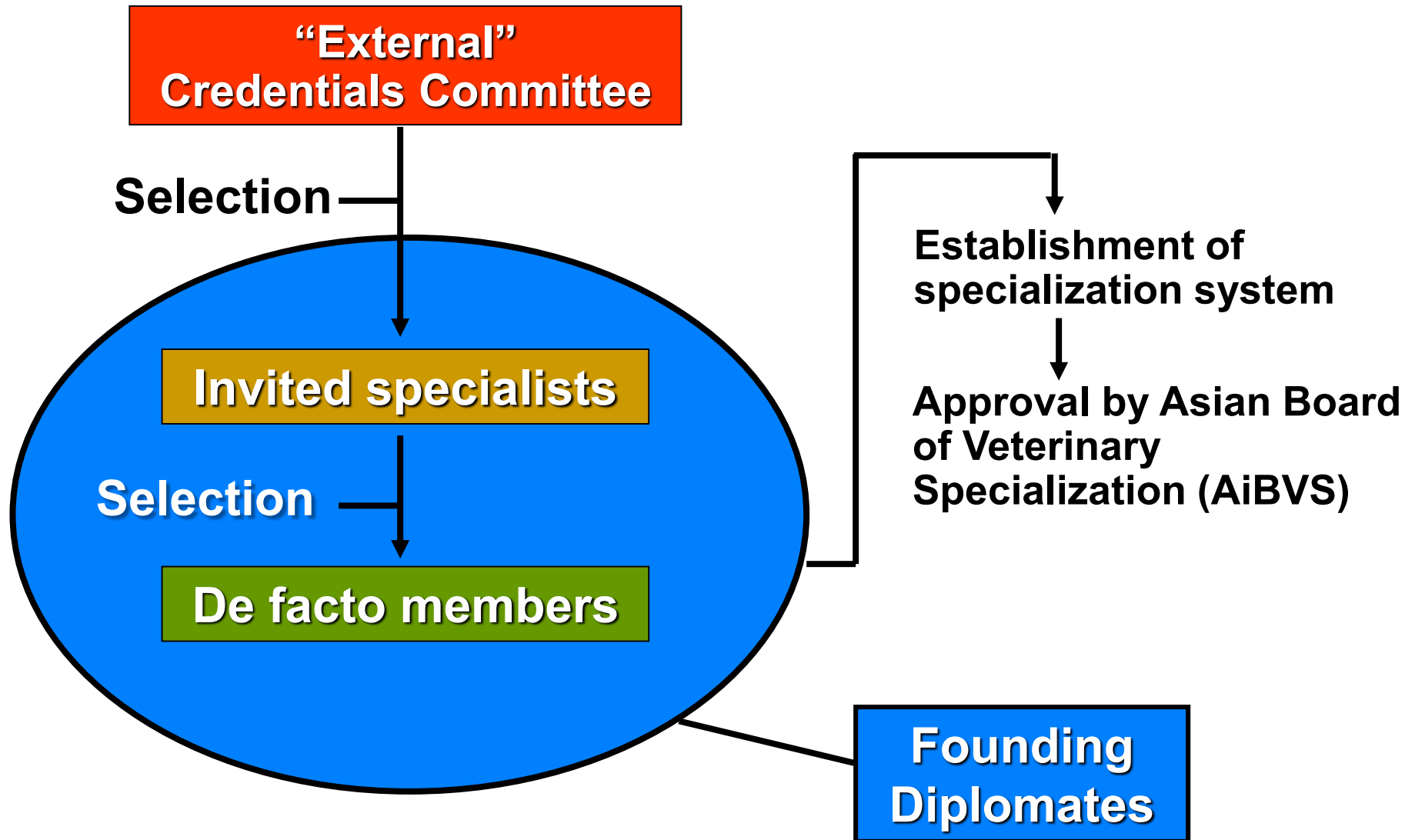
Hayashi asked Prof. Yamashita (AiSVS Treasurer) to assist selecting Anesthesiologist for “External Credential Committee”.

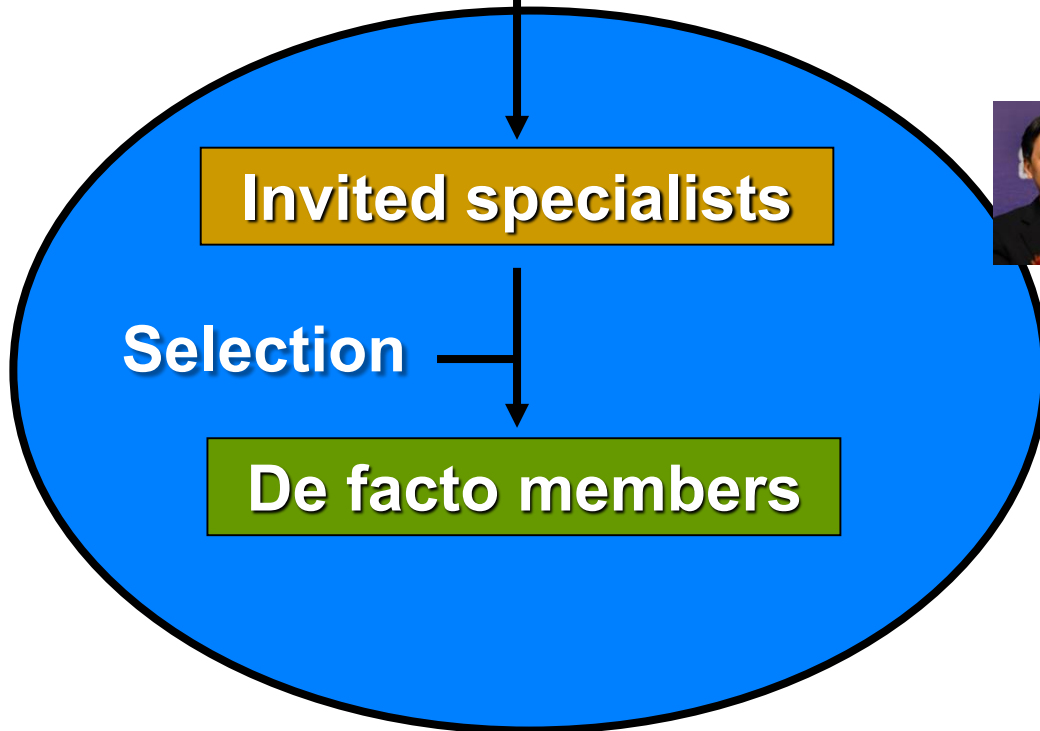

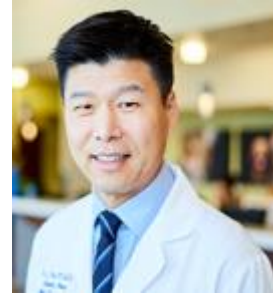
